

CARPARK FUTURES COMPETITION !



DPA-X, Dominique Perrault Architecture's research laboratory, and **Indigo Group**, world leader in parking and mobility, launched an international architecture competition on Tuesday, January 18.

More than a hundred young architects have already registered.

Open to young architects under 40 years of age, registered alone or in a team, "Carpark Futures Competition" invites architecture professionals to question the architectural, urban, technical and environmental potential of a **revalorization of underground parking lots**, through **the study of the Euralille site** in northern France. During a 72 hours competition - **may 20th to may 22th**, the candidates will have to propose a series of architectural interventions in response to new practices related to mobility, urban logistics and, more broadly, to changes in lifestyles and consumer habits.
